Friends of the Riverhead Library's Student Music Award Requirements for Applicants

Applicants shall include the following:

- 1. A record of applicant's high school academic performance.
 - a. Consideration of the academic performance in high school will be evaluated especially considering music grades. Academic achievement and other awards earned will be considered a positive factor.
- 2. Students must complete and submit an essay responding to the subject provided on the application form.
 - a. This essay shall consist of 500 words describing why music is important to them.
- 3. Students will be interviewed and will need to provide a performance for the Friends to demonstrate their musical skills.
 - a. Students must perform an NASM or equivalent score. The performance will be evaluated and will be considered in the Friends' final choice.
- 4. Applicants must provide three references including reference's contact information and relationship to applicant.

A hard copy of the completed information above with a Friends' Music Scholarship form must be received by the Friends at their address: PO Box 1341 Riverhead, NY 11901 by March 30, 2019.

Auditions and interviews shall be scheduled during the month of April.

Evaluation of applications is at the sole discretion of the Friends and their decision shall be final. The presentation of the award shall take place at the Friends general meeting in May and at the Riverhead High Schools Scholarship Award Night.
