Applicants shall include the following:

- 1. A record of applicant's high school academic performance.
- a. Consideration of the academic performance in high school will be evaluated especially considering art grades. Academic achievement and other awards earned will be considered a positive factor.
- 2. Students must complete and submit a statement responding to the subject provided on the application form.
- a. This statement should include what has influenced them in their art and what they hope to do with the scholarship.
- 3. Students will be interviewed and will need to provide a portfolio for the Friends to demonstrate their artistic skills.
- 4. Applicants must provide three references including references contact information and relationship to applicant.

A hard copy of the above must submit a completed Friends' Art Scholarship form and must be received by the Friends at their address:

Reviews and interviews shall be scheduled during the month of April. .

Evaluation of applications is at the sole discretion of the Friends and their decision shall be final. The presentation of the award shall take place at the Friends general meeting in May and at the Riverhead High Schools Scholarship Award Night.
